Communicating with us

Bring a Friend week

The week of October 2nd is "Bring a Friend" week at the studio, all details are included in the attached participation form. Please note: in order for the friend to participate in the class a signed release form must be received prior to that. Please make sure the provided form is filled out in every part as well.

Friends and siblings of students

Leaving a sibling or a friend of your child at the studio unattended is not allowed. If your child's friend or sibling is interested in our classes and wishes to observe one, the studio must be notified, and the adult responsible for bringing them must remain at the studio for the duration of the class. Young siblings must be supervised at all times (no running around please!!!) and engaged in quiet activities. Loud noises can be heard from the studio and can distract students while taking class.

Class attire

Ballet students must wear the required leotard in class as soon as it becomes available at Bodygears, underwear should not be worn under the leotard. Please make sure your child has good tights. Small runs can be stopped with clear nail polish, visible holes are not acceptable. Hair must be styled in a properly made classical ballet bun, an elastic wrapped around the hair does not qualify as a bun. While it's not a difficult task it takes some practice to achieve a proper ballet bun. We will be happy to show you how to make one, but please make sure you bring all the necessary supplies (hair brush, elastic, bobby pins, hair pins, hair net or bun cover) and you come early to allow enough time for the tutorial before the beginning of classes.

Timeliness

It is important that students arrive to the studio a few minutes before class, ready to dance, so we can start classes on time and stay on schedule. Especially for the younger students, please make sure your child uses the bathroom before class so that the flow of activities will not be interrupted by children going in and out of the studio.
